WHAT MUST THE PLAINTIFFS' PROVE TO WIN THE CASE AND DAMAGES?

- 1. That the defendants negligently discharged chemicals;
- 2. that the chemicals entered the town of Woburn drinking water; (requires experts)
- 3. that the chemicals were harmful; (requires experts)
- 4. that the chemicals caused harm to the plaintiffs; (requires experts)
- 5. the amount of damages caused by the harm

All must be proved by a PREPONDERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE (a lesser standard than the criminal standard of proof beyond a reasonable doubt
